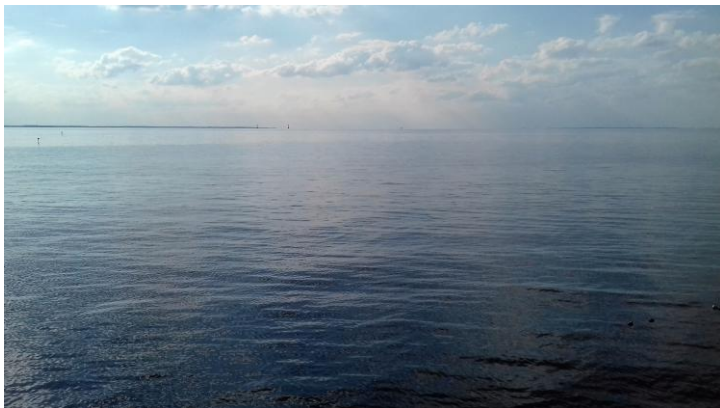




## Common Initiatives in Conserved and Protected Areas
