During CaSYPoT project a survey investigating various areas of young people's lives was carried out in 6 municipalities: Klaipeda in Lithuania, Słupsk and Bartoszyce in Poland, Svetlogorsk and Gusev in Russia and Emmaboda in Sweden. A short summary of the international results will be presented. The results served as basis for further project activities, such as development of youth strategies and implementation of tools for better dialogue with youth.

The SB YCGN (*South Baltic Youth Core Groups Network*) project aims to increase youth participation in decision making on the local level and strengthen the capacities of local and regional actors in the South Baltic Programme area in youth policy and sustainable development. In its lifetime the project has the ambition to create cross border network with joint capacity building events, based on analysis and research of partner countries with following international participatory campaign.

During this seminar presented will be international youth participation survey results (inspired by CaSYPoT questionnaire), as well as consultations with authorities and decision-makers, results of focus group discussions and work on creating local youth core groups.

A good example from the Alps. In the project GaYA (*Governance and Youth in the Alps*), eight partners from five different Alpine countries have worked together for two years to increase the quality of democratic processes in the Alpine space. They collected new democratic methods, tested them in 15 pilot sites and made them available in order to overcome the challenges of territorial cohesion and participatory involvement of young people in political decision-making. The implementation of youth participation in today's governance forms has great potential and is an urgent need for increasing sustainable and fair decision making. Learn about the project results.
