Programme highlights

- Project applications submitted: **145**
- Regular & small-scale projects calls implemented: **5 regular & 3 SSP**
- Ongoing projects: **63 projects (54 regular, 9 small-scale)**
- Organisations involved: **400**
- Programme funds allocated: **97%**



Open calls for proposals

4th Small-scale project call for proposals

6th call for proposals (regular projects)

- Deadline for submission: **4 November 2026**
- Decision on projects' selection: **8 April 2027**



Open calls for proposals

6th call for proposals (regular projects)

- Measure **1.1 Digitalisation**, allocation **1,26 m EUR ERDF**
→ **call specific requirements!!!**
- Measure **4.1 Cooperation capacity**, allocation **~0,78 m EUR ERDF**
- Projects duration: **up to 24 months**

Open calls for proposals

4th Small-scale project call for proposals

- Measure **4.1 Cooperation capacity**, allocation ~**0,32 m EUR ERDF**
- Project budget = **Staff costs + other costs (40% *Staff costs)** up to 200 000,00 EUR
- **18 months** duration
- Thematic Focus:
 - a. Common challenges under M 4.1**
 - b. Capitalising the results** of regular ISBP projects from 1st and 2nd calls for proposals

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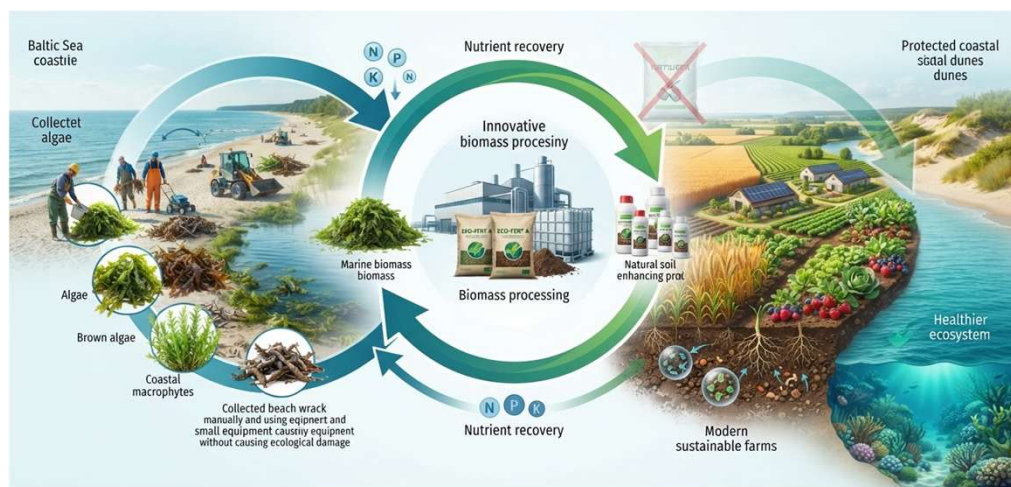
